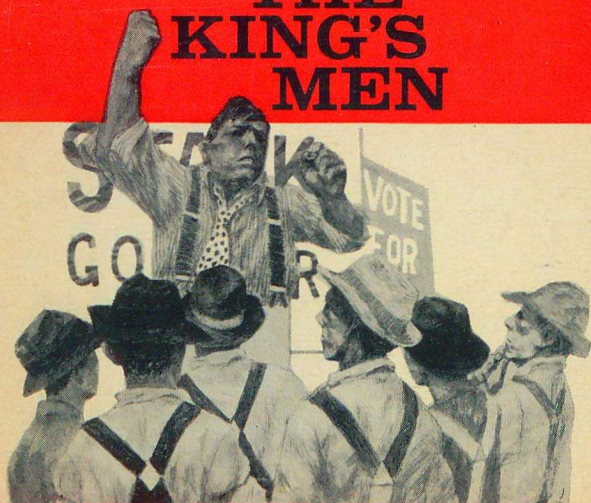

held a teaching fellowship, at Yale, and at
Oxford as a Rhodes Scholar.

education, poetry, criticism, and the novel.

He has won many awards and prizes,
and is largely credited with the renaissance
in Southern writing.
