was born in Kentucky in 1905, and was educated at Vanderbilt University, the University of California, where he held a teaching fellowship, at Yale, and at Oxford as a Rhodes Scholar.

Since 1925 Mr. Warren has been outstanding in American letters, in the fields of education, poetry, criticism, and the novel.

He has won many awards and prizes, and is largely credited with the renaissance in Southern writing.

Many critics regard Mr. Warren's novels as among the most profound and significant of our time.
