There is one simple way to describe this remarkable book: if you want to know what's happening in poetry in this country, you must read it.

These are truly *new* poems. Out of more than two hundred, only two have previously appeared in books. Less than half have appeared in magazines. The majority have not been printed anywhere before.

In these pages you will find such famous names as those on the front cover, plus Babette Deutsch, Edwin Rolfe, Winfield Townley Scott, G. A. Borgese, and Padraic Colum. Included are three Pulitzer Prize winners and two recipients of the National Book Award for Poetry.

There is also an almost equal number of rising stars of the poetry firmament, some of whom are making their first public appearances here. Among these are writers who will be creating much of the important poetry of the next twenty years.

This is not a potpourri of bits. The editor was anxious that each poet should be fairly represented, and not less than two pages are devoted to each of the fifty-three authors.

In addition the editor took as a fundamental thesis of this book that in spite of the current belief that modern verse is obscure and defeatist, there are good poets in this country speaking out clearly and affirmatively. This book is the result of that conviction.
