



Detective-chief-superintendent J. D. Nimmo, head of Manchester CID, has been appointed to investigate recently produced evidence that James Hanratty—hanged in 1962 for the murder of Michael Gregsten on the A6 at Bedford—was in Rhyl at the time of the killing. The inquiry was ordered on January 29 by the Home Secretary. Mr Nimmo has had no links with the case.
